CHAPTER 277

AN ACT to renumber 20.005 (1) (b) (line 190a); and to create 20.005 (1) (b) (line 190a) and 20.16 (7) of the statutes, relating to an annual appropriation of \$5,000 to facilitate instruction in the history and civil government of Wisconsin.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 20.005 (1) (b) (line 190a) of the statutes is renumbered 20.005 (1) (b) (line 190b).

SECTION 2. 20.005 (1) (b) (line 190a) of the statutes is created to read:

20.005 (1) (b)	1955-56	1956-57
190a. Instruction facilities (7)	\$5,000	\$5,000

SECTION 3. 20.16 (7) of the statutes is created to read:

20.16 (7) On July 1, 1955, \$5,000 and on July 1, 1956, \$5,000 to facilitate in the secondary schools of the state, in accordance with s. 44.04, the proper and required instruction in the history and civil government of Wisconsin and to further a proper appreciation of the importance of the individual and the basic values of our American heritage as exemplified in the history of this great state and its several localities and communities.
