CHAPTER 291

AN ACT to create 59.08 (65) of the statutes, relating to appropriation to defray expenses of intergovernmental committees organized to consider governmental problems in counties having a population of 500,000 or more.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

59.08 (65) of the statutes is created to read:

59.08 (65) INTERGOVERNMENTAL COMMITTEES; APPROPRIATION. The county board of any county having a population of 500,000 or more may appropriate money to defray the expenses of any intergovernmental committee organized in the county with participation by the county board to study county wide governmental problems, and make recommendations thereon. All items of expense paid out of the appropriations shall be presented on vouchers signed by the chairman and secretary of the intergovernmental committee.
