CHAPTER 38

AN ACT to create 97.43 (7) of the statutes, relating to the display of the grade in butter advertising.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

97.43 (7) of the statutes is created to read:

97.43 (7) No person, for himself, or as an agent, shall advertise the sale of any butter at a stated price, unless the grade of the butter is set forth in such advertisement in not less than 10 point type.
