CHAPTER 395

- AN ACT to amend 85.40 (6) and 85.91 (1) of the statutes, relating to slow moving vehicles and providing a penalty.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 85.40 (6) of the statutes is amended to read:

85.40 (6) No person shall operate a vehicle upon * * * any highway at a speed so slow as to impede or block the reasonable and lawful movement of traffic. If the operator of the overtaking vehicle gives audible warning with his warning device, the operator of the slow moving vehicle shall if practicable yield the roadway to the overtaking vehicle. Traffic officers may direct such a person to move at a reasonably increased speed or to yield the roadway to overtaking vehicles in accordance with s. 85.12.

SECTION 2. 85.91 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

85.91 (1) Any person violating any provision of ss. 85.11, 85.12 (2), (3), (4) and (6), 85.15 (4), 85.16 (1), (2) and (8), 85.17 (1), (2), (4) and (5), 85.175, 85.176, 85.177, 85.18 (1), (4) to (6) and (8) to (11), 85.19 (2), (3) and (4), 85.21 to 85.23, 85.25 to 85.28, 85.31, 85.33, 85.34 (1), (2) and (4), 85.35, 85.39 (1) and (2), 85.40 (6), 85.44 (1) to (9), 85.45 (6), 85.50, 85.61, 85.63 to 85.66, 85.67 (2) to (7) and 85.69 shall be fined not less than \$10 nor more than \$20 for the first offense and for the second or each subsequent conviction within one year thereafter, shall be fined not less than \$25 nor more than \$50.
