CHAPTER 412

AN ACT to create 59.08 (68) of the statutes, relating to the power of the county board to acquire, maintain and operate recreational areas.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

59.08 (68) of the statutes is created to read:

59.08 (68) RECREATIONAL AREAS. Provide for the construction, maintenance and operation of recreational areas which may include, without restriction for failure of enumeration, a golf course, archery range, tennis courts, skiing and tobogganing facilities, skating, fishing facilities, a family picnic area, skeet and trap field, bridle path and riding facilities and such other recreational facilities as the board may determine. The board may acquire any land necessary to carry out this program.
