CHAPTER 449

AN ACT to amend 158.05 (3) of the statutes, relating to the pay of the barbers' examining committee.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

158.05 (3) of the statutes is amended to read:

158.05 (3) Members of the committee of examiners shall be appointed and hold office for terms of 3 years each. All such terms shall expire on December 31 of the third year next following such appointment. No member shall succeed himself for more than one term and each member shall hold office until his successor is appointed and qualified. Any vacancies on said committee shall be filled by appointment for the unexpired term. Each member of the committee of examiners shall receive a per diem of not to exceed * * * \$25 per day for the actual number of days he is engaged in the performance of his duties including necessary travel time and in addition thereto his actual and necessary expenses.
