## CHAPTER 464

- AN ACT to create 108.04 (13) (e) of the statutes, relating to mandatory notice by governmental employers to the industrial commission that an unemployment benefit claimant may receive retirement payments.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

108.04 (13) (e) of the statutes is created to read:

108.04 (13) (e) Whenever an individual claims benefits based on his employment by a government unit, it shall, if it believes that sub. (15) as to retirement payments may apply, so notify the commission. In any such case the Wisconsin retirement fund and the state teachers retirement system shall, on request from the commission, report to it the relevant facts, and the commission shall apply sub. (15) accordingly.
