- AN ACT to create 85.08 (25c) (am), (26) (am) and (29) (am) of the statutes, relating to fees for drivers licenses after revocation or suspension.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
- 85.08 (25c) (am), (26) (am) and (29) (am) of the statutes are created to read:

- 85.08 (25c) (am) No person 18 years of age or over shall file a petition for an occupational license unless he first pays to the county treasurer a fee of \$10. The treasurer shall give such person a receipt and shall pay the full amount of the fee to the state treasurer, to be deposited in the general fund.
- (26) (am) The payment of a fee of \$10, but this paragraph shall not apply to persons under the age of 18;
- (29) (am) The payment of a fee of \$10, but this paragraph shall not apply to persons under the age of 18;
