## CHAPTER 565

AN ACT authorizing and directing the state department of public welfare to convey certain state-owned lands in the town of Allouez, Brown county, Wisconsin, therein described, to the said town of Allouez for street or highway purposes.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

The state department of public welfare is authorized and directed to convey, for street or highway purposes to the town of Allouez, a municipal corporation, in Brown county, Wisconsin, a part of Lots 39 and 40 of Greene and Vroman Subdivision No. 1 in Private Claim No. 19, East Side of Fox River, and Part of Private Claim No. 20, East Side of Fox River, situated in the Town of Allouez, Brown county, Wisconsin and described as follows:

A parcel of land, 60 feet in width, being 30 feet wide on each side of and adjacent to the following described center line, to-wit:

Beginning at a point in the center line of Libal Street in Greene and Vroman Subdivision No. 1, a distance of 498.63 feet South 26 degrees West from the intersection of the North line of said Lots 39 and 40, with said center line of Libal Street as the point of beginning; thence South 26 degrees 16 minutes West 1169.4 feet to the South line of said Private Claim No. 20, said point being South 64 degrees 16 minutes East 2457.1 feet from the northeast corner of Cady Land Company Riverview Addition, and containing 1.61 acres of land.

As consideration for such conveyance the town of Allouez has agreed to, and shall, when the need therefor arises and the state department of public welfare shall so require, build and maintain an adequate farm fence along either side of said described parcel of land and construct a suitable underground cattle pass across said parcel.
