## CHAPTER 60

AN ACT to amend 66.99 (8) of the statutes, relating to delinquent reports to the federal old-age and survivors insurance system.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

66.99 (8) of the statutes is amended to read:

66.99 (8) Whenever any public agency shall fail to remit within the period fixed by rules and regulations promulgated under sub. (11) any sum payable under sub. (7) the director shall certify to the director of budget and accounts: 1. such sums as may be necessary to reimburse the state for all amounts which it may have paid for such public agency, \* \* \* or 2. any interest \* \* \* or minimum fees due thereon \* \* \* under such rules and regulations, or both; and such shall be included in the next apportionment of state special charges to local units of government.
