CHAPTER 663

AN ACT to create section 2m of chapter 238, laws of 1937, as amended by chapter 322, laws of 1947, relating to the conveyance by the state of Wisconsin to the city of Oshkosh of certain submerged lands for harbor purposes and authorizing the establishment and erection of a water basin for the pre-treatment of the water supply of the city of Oshkosh.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 2m of chapter 238, laws of 1937, as amended by chapter 322, laws of 1947, is created to read:

(Chapter 238, laws of 1937) Section 2m. The submerged lands described in Section 1 hereof granted by the state of Wisconsin to the city of Oshkosh for the purpose of erecting thereon a pier and breakwater, enclosing a harbor for navigation purposes are also hereby granted to the city of Oshkosh for the purpose of the establishment and construction thereon at any desirable location of a water basin for the pre-treatment of the water supply of said city, the plans and specifications for said water basin to be submitted and approved by the state board of health and public service commission.
