**CHAPTER 120**

**AN ACT** to amend 101.06 of the statutes, relating to liability of architects under the safe place statute.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

101.06 of the statutes is amended to read:

101.06 Every employer shall furnish employment which shall be safe for the employes therein and shall furnish a place of employment which

shall be safe for employes therein and for frequenters thereof and shall furnish and use safety devices and safeguards, and shall adopt and use methods and processes reasonably adequate to render such employment and places of employment safe, and shall do every other thing reasonably necessary to protect the life, health, safety, and welfare of such employes and frequenters. Every employer and every owner of a place of employment or a public building now or hereafter constructed shall so construct, repair or maintain such place of employment or public building \* \* \* as to render the same safe.
