CHAPTER 161

AN ACT to repeal and recreate 93.07 (18) (a) and (b) of the statutes, clarifying the authority of the state department of agriculture in respect to the management of state fair park, and granting rule making power.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

93.07 (18) (a) and (b) of the statutes are repealed and recreated to read:

93.07 (18) STATE FAIR PARK. (a) To manage the state fair park and to supervise or conduct thereat fairs, exhibitions or promotional events for agricultural, industrial, educational and recreational purposes; to lease or license the use of any property thereon for other purposes when not needed for the above public purposes; and to charge reasonable rents and fees for use of or attendance at the premises.

(b) To exercise police supervision over the state fair park, and its duly appointed agents or representatives are authorized and empowered to arrest, with or without warrant, any person within such park area, committing an offense against the laws of the state or the rules of the department, and to deliver such person to a proper court in the county and to execute a complaint charging such person with the offense committed.
