CHAPTER 219

AN ACT to amend 29.145 (1a) of the statutes, relating to issuance of permanent fishing licenses without charge to residents over the age of 65 years.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

29.145 (1a) of the statutes is amended to read:

29.145 (1a) The conservation commission is directed upon application therefor to issue a *permanent* fishing license without fee or charge to any person over the age of 65 years who has resided in this state at least one year * * * *and such license shall not expire, but shall be effective so long as the licensee is a resident of this state. If the issuance of such license * * * by some agency other than the conservation commission is authorized* such agency shall not be entitled to any fee or charge for such services.
