**CHAPTER 228**

AN ACT to amend 152.04 of the statutes, relating to examination of applicants for licensure to practice dentistry.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

152.04 of the statutes is amended to read:

152.04 An applicant who has complied with s. 152.03 and who, in the case of one applying for a license after July 1, 1952, holds a certificate of registration in the basic sciences, as provided in ch. 147, shall be examined in writing in such of those subjects usually taught in reputable dental colleges as the board deems necessary. In addition, an applicant shall submit to such practical examination in operative and mechanical dentistry as may be prescribed by the board. *In lieu of its own examination, the board may accept, in whole or in part, the certificate of the national board of dental examiners.*
