CHAPTER 23

AN ACT to create 59.07 (65), 60.18 (23) and 60.29 (43) of the statutes, relating to establishment of rural numbering systems by counties and towns, and co-operation by towns in rural planning.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. 59.07 (65) of the statutes is created to read:

59.07 (65) RURAL NUMBERING SYSTEM. Establish a rural numbering system in towns for the purpose of aiding in fire protection, emergency services, and civil defense, and appropriate and expend money therefor, under which:

(a) Each rural road and each home, business, farm or other establishment, may be assigned a name or number.

(b) Such names or numbers may be displayed on uniform signs posted on rural roads and intersections, and at each home, business, farm or other establishment.

(c) This subsection may be carried out in co-operation with any town or towns in the county.

SECTION 2. 60.18 (23) of the statutes is created to read:

60.18 (23) RURAL NUMBERING SYSTEMS. To raise money to post signs and otherwise co-operate with the county in the establishment of a rural numbering system under s. 59.07 (65).

SECTION 3. 60.29 (43) of the statutes is created to read:

60.29 (43) CO-OPERATE IN COUNTY PLANNING. To co-operate with the county in rural planning under ss. 27.015, 59.07 (65) and 59.97.
