CHAPTER 243

AN ACT to create 29.623 of the statutes, relating to removal of detrimental fish from inland waters by the conservation commission.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

29.623 of the statutes is created to read:

29.623 CONTROL OF DETRIMENTAL FISH. When the commission finds that any species of fish is detrimental to any of the waters of the state it may, by rule, designate such species of fish and specify

the waters in which such fish are found to be detrimental. Thereupon the commission may remove such fish from the waters specified or cause them to be removed therefrom pursuant to ss. 29.62 and 29.625.
