CHAPTER 271

AN ACT to amend 59.19 of the statutes, relating to county treasurer's deputies.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

59.19 of the statutes is amended to read:

59.19 (1) The county treasurer may appoint * * * *in writing one or more deputies* to aid him in the discharge of the duties of his office. Such deputy *or deputies*, in the absence of the treasurer from his office or in case of a vacancy in said office or any disability of the treasurer to perform the duties of his office, unless another is appointed therefor as provided in sub. (2), may perform all the duties of the office of treasurer until such vacancy is filled or such disability is removed. * * * The person *or persons* so appointed shall take and file the official oath. * * * *They* shall file * * * *their* appointment with the county clerk. The county

board, may in its discretion, at its annual meeting or at any special meeting, provide a salary for *each* such deputy.

(2) If any county treasurer is incapable of discharging the duties of his office, the county board may, if they see fit, appoint a person treasurer who shall serve until such disability is removed. A person so appointed or appointed to fill a vacancy in the office of treasurer, upon giving an official bond with like sureties as are required of such treasurer, shall perform all the duties of such office, and thereupon the powers and duties of * * * *any deputy performing the duties* of the last treasurer shall cease.
