CHAPTER 388

AN ACT to create 66.901 (5) (ij) of the statutes, relating to inclusion of certain elected officials under the Wisconsin retirement fund.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

66.901 (5) (ij) of the statutes is created to read:

66.901 (5) (ij) Any elected official of any participating municipality other than the state who prior to January 1, 1948, had been a participating employe of that municipality, and who became an elected official of that municipality prior to January 1, 1952, and who, notwithstanding the failure to make the election required by par. (i), continued without interruption during all of said service as a participating employe and as an elected official to make normal contributions, shall be deemed to have so elected prior to his assumption of office, and his rights and credits as a participating employe under said fund are hereby ratified and confirmed.
