**CHAPTER 96**

AN ACT to create 66.054 (9) (g) of the statutes, relating to dispensing fermented malt beverages to noncitizen persons under 21 years of age.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

66.054 (9) (g) of the statutes is created to read:

66.054 (9) (g) No fermented malt beverages shall be sold, dispensed, given away, or furnished to any person under the age of 21 years who is not a resident of this state and is a resident of any state bordering on Wisconsin which prohibits the sale of fermented malt beverages to any person under the age of 21 years unless he is accompanied by parent or guardian or spouse. For the purposes of this subsection, students may be deemed residents of the municipality in which they reside while attending school and members of the armed services may be deemed residents of the municipality in which they are stationed at the time.
