## CHAPTER 16

AN ACT to amend 252.015 of the statutes, relating to an additional judge for the twenty-second judicial circuit.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 252.015 of the statutes is amended to read:

252.015 Each branch of circuit court constitutes a court with all the powers and jurisdiction possessed by circuit courts in circuits having one judge only, and may be designated in all papers and proceedings either by its respective number or by the name of its presiding judge. The second circuit shall have 10 branches. The ninth circuit shall have 3 branches. The twenty-second circuit shall have 2 branches.

SECTION 2. An additional judge for the twenty-second judicial circuit shall be elected in the several election precincts of Waukesha county on the first Tuesday of April 1960, in accordance with the laws relating to the election of circuit judges. The term of office of the judge chosen at such election shall commence on the first Monday of May 1960, and expire on the first Monday of January 1966. Thereafter the term shall commence on the first Monday of January. SECTION 3. The branch of the twenty-second judicial circuit presided over by the judge thereof on the effective date of this act constitutes branch No. 1; and the branch to be presided over by the additional judge of said circuit shall be branch No. 2.

SECTION 4. This bill is declared to be an emergency executive budget bill in accordance with the provisions of section 15.11 (2) of the statutes.
