## CHAPTER 520

AN ACT to repeal 29.105 (4); to amend 29.174 (1); and to create 29.107 (5) of the statutes, relating to the issuance of deer hunting licenses and deer hunting party permits.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 29.105 (4) of the statutes is repealed.

SECTION 2. 29.107 (5) of the statutes is created to read:

29.107 (5) All licensing depots shall be closed to the issuance of such deer hunting party permits from the close of business on November 20 to December 31 in each year.

SECTION 3. 29.174 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

29.174 (1) There shall be established and maintained, as hereinafter provided, such open and close seasons for the several species of fish and game, and such bag limits, size limits, rest days and conditions governing the taking of fish and game as will conserve the fish and game supply and insure the citizens of this state continued opportunities for good fishing, hunting and trapping \* \* \* \*. Except for the Apostle Islands other than Madeline Island no deer hunting license shall be valid in a designated area if dated on or after the opening date for the deer season for such area unless the open season in an area overlaps the open season in another area in which case deer hunting licenses dated before the opening date in any area shall be valid in any other area during the period such seasons overlap.
