CHAPTER 19

AN ACT to create 72.11 (4) of the statutes, relating to conditions precedent to delivery or transfer of securities in the joint name of a decedent and others.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

72.11 (4) of the statutes is created to read:

72.11 (4) SUFFICIENCY OF COUNTY COURT ORDER TERMINATING JOINT TENANCY. In all cases in which the certificate of the county court terminating a joint tenancy certifies or finds that no tax was due thereon or that the tax has been determined and paid and that due notice of determination of the tax was given to or duly waived by the department, such certificate or a certified copy thereof shall be conclusive as to the factual matters so certified or found, and nothing further shall be required from the department of taxation or otherwise as a condition precedent to the delivery or transfer of any stocks, bonds or other securities included in the property to which such certificate relates.
