CHAPTER 235

AN ACT to amend 40.34 (2) (a) of the statutes, relating to facsimile signatures on school district order checks.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

40.34 (2) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

40.34 (2) (a) Apply for, receive, and if necessary sue for all money appropriated to or collected for the district, and disburse the same * * * as provided by s. 66.042 on the order of the clerk, countersigned by the director. In every school district, except a city school district * * * all disbursements from the treasury shall be made by the treasurer upon the written order of the clerk after proper vouchers have been filed with the clerk; such disbursements shall be by order check and no order check shall be released to the payee, nor shall it be valid, unless signed by the clerk and treasurer and countersigned by the director, except that in school districts having 5 or more school board members such disbursements may be by order checks signed by the clerk and treasurer and any other one member of the board. No order shall be drawn for the payment of which money has not been appropriated according to law. *The school board may, by resolution, a certified copy of which shall be filed with the school clerk and the public depositories concerned, authorize the use of facsimile signatures as provided in s. 66.042 (3).*
