## CHAPTER 24

AN ACT to amend 129.17 of the statutes, relating to peddling finger alphabet cards, and providing a penalty.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

129.17 of the statutes is amended to read:

129.17 No person shall in this state engage in the business of peddling finger alphabet cards or printed matter stating that the person is deaf, or use finger alphabet cards or such printed matter *or masquerade as a deaf person* in any way as a means of inducement in the sale of merchandise; and no state or local license as provided in this chapter shall be issued to any person for the purpose of peddling finger alphabet cards or printed matter stating that the person is deaf *or masquerading as a deaf person*. Any person who \* \* \* *peddles* finger alphabet cards or such printed matter or \* \* \* *uses* the same, *or masquerades as a deaf person* in any way as a means of inducement in the sale of merchandise in this state and any person who \* \* \* *issues* any state or local license as provided in this chapter for that purpose \* \* \* *may be imprisoned* not more than \* \* \* *90 days* or \* \* \* *fined* not less than \* \* \* *\$25* nor more than \* \* \* *\$100* or both.
