CHAPTER 260

AN ACT authorizing the state department of public welfare to sell and convey the state-owned granite quarry known as the Amberg Quarry in Marinette county, Wisconsin, and crediting the net proceeds therefrom to the appropriation made by section 20.670 (65) (b) of the statutes.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

The director of the state department of public welfare, with the approval of the governor, is authorized to sell and convey the state-owned granite quarry known as the Amberg Quarry, together with buildings and

equipment, located on the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 2, T. 35 N., R.20E., Marinette county, Wisconsin, under such terms, conditions and covenants as the director determines; and the net proceeds of such sale or sales shall be deposited in the general fund and credited to the appropriation made by section 20.670 (65) (b) of the statutes.
