CHAPTER 286

AN ACT to amend 29.145 (1) of the statutes, relating to fishing licenses for physically and mentally handicapped children at the north, south and central colonies.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

29.145 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

29.145 (1) Any person under the age of 16 years or over the age of 65 years who has resided in this state for one year * * *, any person who is totally blind *and any physically or mentally handicapped individual committed to the north, south or central colony and training school, during the period of their commitment* may without license take, catch or kill fish subject to all other provisions of law; but no other person between the ages of 16 and 65 years who has resided in this state for a period of one year shall take, catch or kill fish, or fish for fish with hook and line or with rod and reel in any of the inland waters of this state unless a resident fishing license has been duly issued to him, subject to all other provisions of law, but no license shall be required of any person to set, place or use in any waters in this state any landing net, dip net, minnow seine or minnow dip net for fish other than game fish.
