CHAPTER 314

AN ACT to create 20.670 (37) and 53.20 of the statutes, relating to the state department of public welfare furnishing standard uniforms to correctional officers in the department who are required to wear uniforms and making an appropriation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 20.670 (37) of the statutes is created to read:

20.670 (37) UNIFORMS FOR CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS. On July 1, 1961, \$31,500 and on July 1, 1962, \$31,500 for supplying standard uniforms and insignia to correctional officers in the department requiring uniforms, as provided in s. 53.20.

SECTION 2. 53.20 of the statutes is created to read:

53.20 UNIFORMS FOR CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS. The department shall furnish and, from time to time replace, a standard uniform to be prescribed by the department including items of clothing (not including overcoats), shoulder patches, caps, lapel insignia, and badge to each correctional officer in the department who is required to wear such standard uniform.
