CHAPTER 487

AN ACT to create 253.10 (11) of the statutes, relating to the jurisdiction of the probate branches of the county court in counties of a population of 500,000 or more.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 253.10 (11) of the statutes is created to read:

253.10 (11) In counties having a population of 500,000 or more, the probate jurisdiction, in addition to the foregoing, shall include matters

under chs. 50, 51, 142, 157 and 322, and ss. 46.10, 48.81 to 48.97, 52.01, 231.36, 319.31 and 319.61 to 319.71. The jurisdiction of matters under ch. 51 shall be concurrent with branches 3, 4 and 12.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect when the court reorganization act takes effect on the first Monday in January 1962.
