CHAPTER 604

AN ACT to create 20.555 (41a) of the statutes, relating to the refund of the net license fee paid for hunting and voluntary sportsmen's licenses to members of the Wisconsin national guard or armed services reserve units called to active duty.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

20.555 (41a) of the statutes is created to read:

20.555 (41a) REFUNDS. The Wisconsin conservation commission shall refund the net license fee received from the sale of 1961 hunting and voluntary sportsmen's licenses to any resident of Wisconsin on or before the

day he was notified that he would be called to active service in the armed forces under P. L. 87–117. No such refund may be granted unless the licensee returns his license and any tags issued with the license to the conservation commission for cancellation together with an affidavit stating that he has not hunted, fished, trapped or otherwise availed himself of any of the privileges covered by the license. Applications for such refunds must be filed by the licensee with the conservation commission prior to January 1, 1962.
