## **CHAPTER 64**

AN ACT to amend 45.052 (1) (d) of the statutes, relating to memorial corporations and staggering terms of office of members on the governing bodies thereof.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

45.052 (1) (d) of the statutes is amended to read:

45.052 (1) (d) It shall have a membership composed of 5 residents of the city, village or town in which the memorial is located, one appointed by the common council of the city, village board or town board of said city, village or town, and 4 by the county judge of the county in which the memorial is located. The commission or board may appoint 2 additional members who are residents of this state. The terms of all members shall be 5 years. In order that terms of members may expire at different times not more than 2 members shall be appointed in any one year in addition to appointments made to fill vacancies occurring by resignation or death. Members shall hold office until their successors are appointed and qualify.
