**CHAPTER 260**

AN ACT to amend 147.13 (1) and 147.175 (2) of the statutes, relating to daily compensation for the state board of medical examiners and to the annual registration fee for physicians.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. 147.13 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

147.13 (1) The Wisconsin state board of medical examiners shall consist of 8 members appointed by the governor, 7 of whom shall be licensed

resident doctors of medicine and one of whom shall be a licensed resident doctor of osteopathy. The 7 doctors of medicine may, but need not, be selected from nominees of the state medical society and the doctor of osteopathy from nominees of the Wisconsin osteopathic association. The appointment of each member shall be for 4 years. No instructor, stockholder, member of, or person financially interested in any school, college or university having a medical department, or of any school of osteopathy, shall be eligible. Each member of the board shall be paid such compensation as the board determines, and, except for the secretary, not more than \* \* \* \$25 per day, when actually and necessarily engaged in his duties. The secretary shall receive such compensation as the board determines, but not less than \$1,800 annually.

SECTION 2. 147.175 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

147.175 (2) Each registrant shall pay for such registration a fee to be fixed by the Wisconsin state board of medical examiners for each given year, which fee shall not exceed \* \* \* \$10 in any year \* \* \*. Those who register after January 31 of a given year shall \* \* \* pay whatever fee has been fixed for that year.
