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CHAPTER 338

AN ACT to amend section 1 of chapter 116, laws of 1901, as last amended by chapter 288, laws of 1913, amending the charter of Lawrence College.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Chapter 116, laws of 1901, section 1 as last amended by chapter 288, laws of 1913, is amended to read:

Chapter 1 of the general laws of the territory of Wisconsin, of 1847; chapter 133, laws of 1849; chapter 176, private and local laws of 1855; chapter 126, private and local laws of 1858; chapter 123, general laws of 1878; chapter 16, general laws of 1882; and chapter 16, laws of 1895, are hereby amended * * * to read * * * : Gov. Henry Dodge, Hon. Mason C. Darling, Hon. Morgan L. Martin, Hon. Nathaniel P. Tallmadge, Prof. DeWitt C. Vosburg [Vosberry], Rev. Reeder Smith, Henry R. Colman, William H. Sampson, Henry S. Baird, Jacob L. Bean, William Dutcher, George E. H. Day [Davy], Loyal H. Jones, and their successors be, and they are hereby created a body politic and corporate to be styled * * * Lawrence College of Wisconsin and by that name to remain in perpetual succession. The design and purpose of the said corporation is hereby declared to be, to found, establish and maintain at Appleton, in the county of Outagamie, an institution of learning on a plan sufficiently extensive to afford instruction in the liberal arts and sciences and to develop the scholar; and * * * *the* trustees may, as their ability shall increase, erect any or all of the different departments for the study of the liberal professions in such manner as they may think proper.
