**CHAPTER 35**

**AN ACT** to amend 348.25 (4) of the statutes, relating to the issuance of permits for vehicles and loads of excessive size and weight.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

348.25 (4) of the statutes is amended to read:

348.25 (4) Permits shall be issued only for the transporting of a single article or vehicle which exceeds statutory size, weight or load limita-

tions and which cannot reasonably be divided or reduced to comply with statutory size, weight or load limitations, except that a permit may be issued for the transportation of property consisting of more than one article, *some or* all of which exceed statutory size limitations, provided statutory gross weight limitations are not thereby exceeded and provided the additional articles transported do not cause the vehicle and load to exceed statutory size limitations in any way in which such limitations would not be exceeded by the single article.,
