CHAPTER 134

AN ACT to create 59.07 (25) of the statutes, relating to county boards in populous counties and authorizing them to own a professional baseball team.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

59.07 (25) of the statutes is created to read:

59.07 (25) BASEBALL. In counties having a population of 500,000 or more own and operate a professional baseball team, appropriate money for the purchase of a franchise for such team, and in the discretion of the board organize and maintain a nonprofit corporation for such team ownership and operation or participate with others in the formation and operation of such corporation.
