

CHAPTER 30

AN ACT to renumber and amend 43.13; and to amend 35.03 (8), 35.85 (7) and 35.93 (6) (intro. par.) and (d) of the statutes, relating to retention of documents by the legislative reference bureau.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. 35.03 (8) of the statutes is amended to read:

35.03 (8) Co-operate with the state historical society in enforcing s. 35.85 (7) and (12) and in providing data for the periodic checklist of public documents required by s. 44.06 (5), and with the legislative reference ~~library~~ bureau in enforcing s. ~~43.13~~ 35.85 (11m), and extend similar assistance to other state agencies to whom distribution of state publications is required by law.

SECTION 2. 35.85 (7) of the statutes is amended to read:

35.85 (7) There shall be delivered to the state historical society 3 copies of every document reproduced at the expense of the state. The chief clerks of the legislature are responsible for the delivery of all legislative documents, and the director for all other public documents. Distribution shall also be made to the legislative reference ~~library~~ bureau in accordance with s. ~~43.13~~ sub. (11m).

SECTION 3. 35.93 (6) (intro. par.) and (d) of the statutes are amended to read:

35.93 (6) The free distribution provided for in this subsection is in lieu of any free distribution which may be prescribed by s. 35.84, 35.85, 35.86, ~~43.13~~ or 43.14. The director shall distribute copies of the code (including the table of contents, index, and necessary binders) and issues of the register free, as follows:

(d) To the state library and legislative reference ~~library~~ bureau, 2 copies each;

SECTION 4. 43.13 of the statutes is renumbered 35.85 (11m) and amended to read:

35.85 (11m) The proper officers of the respective houses of the legislature or the department of administration, as the case may be, shall promptly deliver to the legislative reference bureau, as printed or otherwise reproduced, 3 copies of each message, report, journal, legislative bill, bulletin, circular or public documents of whatever character, printed or otherwise reproduced at the expense of the state. Three copies of all other ~~such printed publications of whatever character~~, *excluding forms*, shall be delivered to the legislative reference bureau by the department, agency or commission of origin. *At least one copy of each document received by the legislative reference bureau under this section shall become part of the bureau's permanent, noncirculating, reference collection of Wisconsin state documents.*
