## CHAPTER 475

- AN ACT to amend 13.057 (1) of the statutes, as affected by chapter 66, laws of 1965, relating to increased membership on the legislative committee to visit state institutions.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
- 13.057 (1) of the statutes, as affected by chapter 66, laws of 1965, is amended to read:
- 13.057 (1) A committee consisting of 3.5 senators and 4.6 assemblymen, the members of which shall be appointed as are committees in each house, is created. This The committee shall visit state institutions either in groups or individually as assigned by the chairman with the consent of the committee. Each member shall participate in the visits to which he is assigned, but if the appointed member of the state building commission is unable to participate in a specific visit he shall appoint an

alternate member, selected from his house of the legislature, to participate in his place. The committee shall inspect buildings, equipment, lands and management of the institutions; it shall have access to all parts of the institutions and to all inmates thereof; it shall make such examination as it may see sees fit of any condition found, and report in writing to the legislature such suggestions as to the needs of any institution as it may deem deems proper. The members of the committee shall be reimbursed their expenses as provided in s. 20.530 (1) (c). The committee shall elect one of its members as chairman and one as secretary. The chairman shall have the provisions of this section carried out by the members of the committee. Prior to the May 1 of each odd-numbered year expiration date of the terms of its members, the committee shall submit its biennial report to the governor and to the legislature.
