CHAPTER 177, LAWS OF 1967

AN ACT to amend 101.31 (7) (f) of the statutes, relating to the use of the word "engineering" in the name of a firm, partnership or corporation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

101.31 (7) (f) of the statutes is amended to read:

101.31 (7) (f) Any firm, partnership or corporation using the word "engineering" or any of its derivatives in its ~~firm, partnership or corporation~~ name prior to April 24, 1964, shall be permitted to continue to do so *and shall be permitted to use such word in any new firm, partnership or corporation formed as a result of a reorganization of such firm, partnership or corporation*, provided ~~such firm, partnership or corporation~~ it does not practice or offer to practice architecture or professional engineering unless they comply with all other provisions of this section.
