## CHAPTER 300, LAWS OF 1967

AN ACT to renumber and amend 344.46 (1); and to amend 344.38 of the statutes, relating to the obligations of an owner of motor vehicles operated by himself or his employes.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 344.38 of the statutes is amended to read:

844.38 Whenever any person required to give proof of financial responsibility for the future under this chapter is or later becomes an operator in the employ of any owner, or is or later becomes a member of the immediate family or household of the owner, the commissioner shall accept proof given by such owner in lieu of proof by such other person. If the vehicle is leased to the employer, then the leasing company may file proof of financial responsibility on behalf of the person required to furnish such proof. When proof has been given as provided in this section, the person on whose behalf such owner gave proof was furnished may be granted a license, but only to operate those vehicles for which proof was so given. The department shall note such restriction on the person's license, including a designation of each vehicle for which proof was given.

SECTION 2. 344.46 (1) of the statutes is renumbered 344.46 (1) (a) and amended to read:

344.46 (1) (a) No owner of a motor vehicle involved in an accident in this state which is reportable under s. 346.70 shall transfer the ownership or registration of such any vehicle whose registration is subject to suspension under s. 344.14 until this chapter has been complied with or until the commissioner is satisfied that such transfer is proposed in good faith and not for the purpose or with the effect of defeating the purposes of this chapter.
