CHAPTER 308, LAWS OF 1967

AN ACT to authorize the secretary of health and social services to sell a piece of land to the Allouez water department.

*The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

The secretary of health and social services is authorized to sell for its appraised value to the Allouez water department a piece of land approximately 80 feet by 220 feet, such land being a part of the Wisconsin state reformatory lands and to be used for water storage, described as follows:

A part of Private Claim No. 19 East Side of Fox River in the Town of Allouez, Brown County, Wisconsin, and described as follows:

"Beginning at the intersection of the centerline of Private Claim 19 East Side of Fox River and the West line of Webster Avenue said intersection being the Southeast corner of Lot Eleven (11), of Greene & Vroman's Subdivision No. 4; thence Westerly along the centerline of said Private Claim, being the South line of said Lot Eleven (11) a distance of 220 feet; thence Southerly and parallel with the West line of said Webster Avenue 80 feet; thence Easterly and parallel with the centerline of said Private Claim 220 feet to the West line of said Webster Avenue; thence North-erly along the West line of said Webster Avenue 80 feet to the place of beginning and containing 0.40 acres of land." This parcel of land being a part of Volume 100 of Deeds, Page 291-92, Document No. 618, or Volume 192 of Deeds, Page 153, Document No. 123405, Brown County Records.
