**CHAPTER 67, LAWS OF 1967**

AN ACT to amend 29.57 (4) of the statutes, relating to wildlife refuges.  
*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly,  
do enact as follows:*

29.57 (4) of the statutes is amended to read:

29.57 (4) No owner of lands embraced within any such wildlife refuge, and no other person whatever, shall hunt or trap within the boundaries of any wildlife refuge, state park ~~except deer on Rock Island state park,~~ or state fish hatchery lands; nor have in his possession or under his control therein any gun or rifle, unless the same is unloaded and knocked down or enclosed within its carrying case; but *deer may be hunted in those state parks or portions thereof designated by the conservation commission.* Nothing ~~herein in this section~~ shall prohibit, prevent or interfere with the state conservation commission, or its deputies, agents or employes, in the destruction of injurious animals.
