**CHAPTER 273, LAWS OF 1969**

AN ACT to amend 103.78 (1) (d) of the statutes, relating to minors presenting musical entertainment at certain dances.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

103.78 (1) (d) of the statutes is amended to read:

103.78 (1) (d) Except as provided in s. 103.69 (3), the employment or appearance shall at no time be in a roadhouse, cabaret, dance hall, night club, tavern or other similar place. *This prohibition shall not apply to minors presenting musical entertainment at dances held in any hall on Friday, Saturday or on any other day not followed by a school day or before midnight on Sunday, if the hall was rented for the purpose of celebrating a special event, including but not limited to a wedding, holiday, birthday or anniversary.*
