CHAPTER 294, LAWS OF 1969

AN ACT to renumber 115.28 (7); and to create 115.28 (7) (b) of the statutes, relating to the issuance of licenses and certificates to teachers in private schools and increasing an appropriation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 115.28 (7) of the statutes is renumbered 115.28 (7) (a).

SECTION 2. 115.28 (7) (b) of the statutes is created to read:

115.28 (7) (b) Subject to the same rules and laws concerning qualifications of applicants and granting and revocation of licenses or certificates under par. (a), the state superintendent shall grant certificates and licenses to teachers in private schools, except that teaching experience requirements for such certificates and licenses may be fulfilled by teaching experience in either public or private schools. An applicant is not eligible for a license or certificate unless the state superintendent finds that the private school in which the applicant taught offered an adequate educational program during the period of the applicant's teaching therein. Private schools are not obligated to employ only licensed or certified teachers.

SECTION 3. The appropriation under section 20.255 (2) (a) of the statutes, as affected by chapter 154, laws of 1969, is increased by \$22,900 for the 1969-70 fiscal year and by \$22,500 for the 1970-71 fiscal year to provide funds for administrative costs under this act.
