**CHAPTER 34, LAWS OF 1969**

AN ACT to amend 117.01 (2) (a) of the statutes, relating to the content of school district reorganization orders (suggested as remedial legislation by department of public instruction).

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

117.01 (2) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

117.01 (2) (a) Every order of school district reorganization shall state the school districts from which any territory is detached, describe such territory and indicate the territory included within the reorganized school district. When the order creates a new school district, the order also shall number the reorganized school district, name the school district according to the municipalities in which it is located, *state the type of school district*

CHAPTER 34

*pursuant to s. 115.01 (3) and the grades to be taught by the district pursuant to s. 115.01 (2)*, designate the number of school board members under s. 120.01, 120.42 or 120.72 and the method of election under s. 120.04, 120.05, 120.06 or 120.43 and fix the time and place for the first annual meeting if one is to be held. The secretary of the agency school committee with whom the order is filed shall give notice of the first annual meeting, if one is to be held, under s. 120.08 (1) (c) and shall act or designate a person to act as temporary chairman of the annual meeting until a chairman is elected.
