CHAPTER 464, LAWS OF 1969

AN ACT to amend 340.01 (29) and 341.25 (1) (j); and to create 340.01 (6m) and (33m) of the statutes, relating to the definitions of mobile homes, motor homes and camping trailers.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 2. 340.01 (6m) and (33m) of the statutes are created to read:

340.01 (6m) "Camping trailer" means a vehicle with a collapsible or folding structure designed for human habitation and towed upon a highway by a motor vehicle.

(33m) "Motor home" means a motor vehicle designed to be operated upon a highway for use as a temporary or recreational dwelling and having the same internal characteristics and equipment as a mobile home.

SECTION 3. 340.01 (29) of the statutes is amended to read:

340.01 (29) "Mobile home" means a vehicle designed to be drawn towed as a single unit or in sections upon a highway by a motor vehicle and designed, equipped and used, or intended to be used, primarily for eleoping, eating and living quarters human habitation, with walls of rigid uncollapsible construction. A mobile home exceeding statutory size under s. 348.07 (2) shall be considered a primary housing unit. A mobile home not exceeding the statutory size under s. 348.07 (2) shall be considered a touring or recreational unit.

SECTION 4. 341.25 (1) (j) of the statutes is amended to read:

341.25 (1) (j) All fees and provisions applicable to the registration of private automobiles also apply to the registration of $\frac{1}{5 \text{ clf-propelled}}$ mobile homes motor homes.
