## CHAPTER 484, LAWS OF 1969

AN ACT to renumber 103.85 (4); to renumber and amend 103.85 (3m); and to amend 103.85 (2) of the statutes, relating to required rest days for laborers.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. 103.85 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

103.85 (2) This section does not apply to: (a) janitors; (b) watchmen; (c) persons employed in the manufacture of butter, cheese or other dairy products or in the distribution of milk or cream, or in canneries and freezers; (d) persons employed in bakeries, flour and feed mills, hotels, and restaurants; (e) employes whose duties include no work on Sunday other than 1. caring for live animals, 2. maintaining fires; (f) any labor called for by an emergency that could not reasonably have been anticipated.

Section 2. 103.85 (3m) of the statutes, as affected by chapter 276, laws of 1969, is renumbered 103.85 (4) and amended to read:

103.85 (4) If upon investigation, the department shall ascertain and determine that there be practical difficulties or unnecessary hardships in carrying out the provisions of this section, or upon a joint request of labor and management, the department may by general or special order make reasonable exceptions therefrom or modifications thereof provided that the life, health, safety and welfare of employes shall not be sacrificed or endangered thereby. Such investigation and orders shall be made pursuant to the proceedings in ss. 101.01 to 101.28; and every order of the department under this section shall have the same force and effect as the orders issued pursuant to said sections. Such orders shall be subject to review in the manner provided in under ch. 227.

Section 3. 103.85 (4) of the statutes is renumbered 103.85 (5). Approved March 2, 1970.
