## CHAPTER 58, LAWS OF 1969

AN ACT to repeal and recreate 36.06 (4); and to create 37.02 (6) of the statutes, relating to housing preferences at the state universities and the university of Wisconsin, and granting rule-making power.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. 36.06 (4) of the statutes is repealed and recreated to read: 36.06 (4) Preference as to rooming, boarding and apartment facilities in the use of living units owned or operated by the university shall, for the following school year, be given to students who are legal residents of this state and who apply before March 15, unless a later date is set by the board of regents. Such preference shall be granted in accordance with categories of priority established by the board of regents. Leases or other agreements for occupancy of such living units shall not exceed a term of one calendar year. The board of regents may prescribe rules for the execution of this subsection.

Section 2. 37.02 (6) of the statutes is created to read:

37.02 (6) Preference as to rooming, boarding and apartment facilities in the use of living units owned or operated by the state universities shall, for the following school year, be given to students who are legal residents of this state and who apply before March 15, unless a later date is set by the board of regents. Such preference shall be granted in accordance with categories of priority established by the board of regents. Leases or other agreements of occupancy of such living units shall not exceed a term of one calendar year. The board of regents may prescribe rules for the execution of this subsection.
