CHAPTER 116, Laws of 1971

AN ACT to create 61.75 of the statutes, relating to offering of rewards in villages.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

61.75 of the statutes is created to read:

61.75 REWARDS. The provisions of s. 62.26 (4) shall apply to villages. As used in said section, the term "mayor" shall mean "village president" and the term "aldermen" shall mean "village trustees".
