CHAPTER 2, Laws of 1971

AN ACT to amend 16.45 of the statutes, relating to the governor's budget message to the legislature.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

16.45 of the statutes is amended to read:

16.45 BUDGET MESSAGE TO LEGISLATURE. ~~Not later than February 1~~ ~~in~~ In each regular session of the legislature, the governor shall deliver his budget message to the 2 houses in joint session assembled. Unless a later date is requested by the governor and approved by the legislature in the form of a joint resolution, the budget message shall be delivered on or before February 1. With such message ~~he~~ the governor shall transmit to the legislature the biennial state budget report and the executive budget bills together with suggestions for the best methods for raising the needed revenues.
