CHAPTER 208, Laws of 1971

AN ACT to amend 346.07 (1) of the statutes, relating to warnings required of passing motor vehicles.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

346.07 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

346.07 (1) The operator of an overtaking motor vehicle not within a business or residence district shall give audible warning with his warning device before passing or attempting to pass on the left a vehicle proceeding in the same direction. This <u>subsection</u> shall <u>not apply on a highway having 2 or more lanes available for</u> traffic in the same direction, except when reasonably <u>necessary</u> to warn the operator of the vehicle about to be passed.
